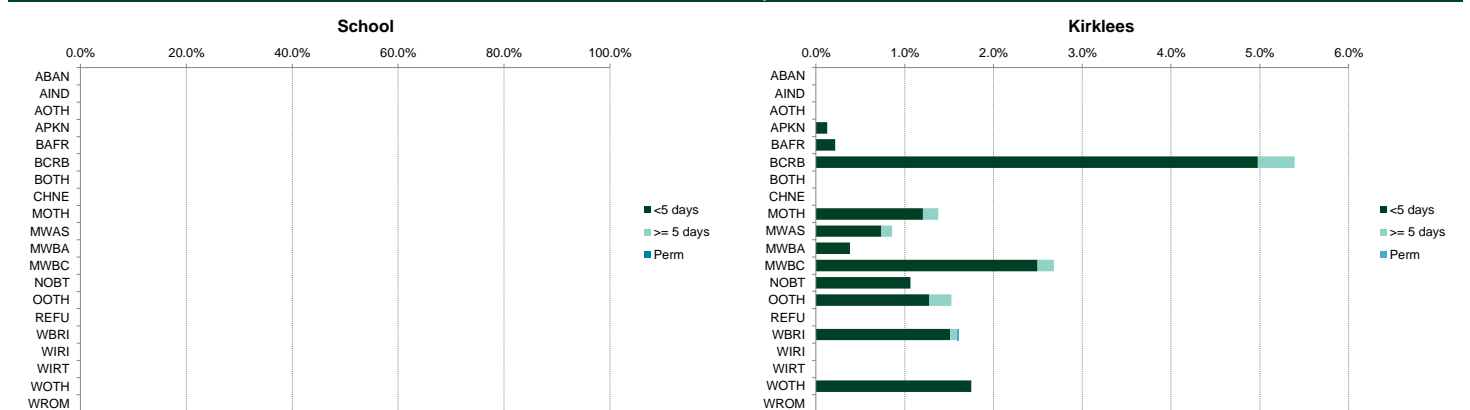
**Gender and Free School Meal Eligibility**
